Urgent Community Response

- NHS Urgent Community Response (UCR) services were required to be in place across England by the end of March 2022
 - UCR services also referred to as crisis response/rapid response services
- NHS UCR Teams are multi-disciplinary and respond to a crisis in somebody's home/usual place of residence (including residential and nursing homes). They can:
 - draw on a wide range of skills, including, advanced clinical practitioners, specialist nurses, occupational therapists, physiotherapists, paramedics and therapy assistants
 - o carry out assessments, provide treatment and order equipment within two hours of referral
 - o support patients for up to 14 days to ensure they stay safe at home.

(A crisis is a sudden deterioration in a person's health & well-being or social care need that requires urgent treatment or support within 2hrs in the home/usual place of residence)

- UCR services can:
 - o help people maintain their independence and manage complex/long-term conditions
 - help support winter resilience initiatives
 - o prevent avoidable ambulance call out and ease pressure on acute and emergency services
 - help avoid unnecessary hospital admission.

UCR Criteria

Who is the service for...

- Adult patients/residents, over 18 in crisis in their own home or residential/care home setting
- Need intervention, within two-hours to stay safely at home/usual place of residence, and avoid admission to hospital.

UCR is not for those...

- Acutely unwell or injured, require emergency care intervention and admission to acute hospital bed
- Need acute/complex diagnostics and care
- Experiencing mental health crisis and require referral/ assessment by specialist mental health team.

UCR Service Requirements

Service requirements

- 8am-8pm, 7 days a week at a minimum
- Patient contacted within two hours of referral
- Supported for up to 14 days with monitoring and treatment to ensure they stay safe at home

UCR referrals accepted

- NHS 111
- 999
- Emergency departments
- General practice/GPs
- Social care providers including personal assistants
- Clinical hubs in ambulance control rooms & patient facing ambulance clinicians
- Specialist services
- Care workers
- TEC/Pendant alarm companies
- Local authorities
- Care homes

Self-referrals from individuals and their carers also accepted

Conditions/Clinical Areas Covered

The following conditions/clinical areas can be covered by UCR services (not an exhaustive list, these are aspects of common clinical conditions or needs that may lead to a patient requiring a two-hour response in a crisis).


UCR London Service Provision
