

International Firefighters' Day is celebrated on 4 May every year. The symbol of the red and blue ribbon is representative of the elements of fire and water as depicted in the ribbon above.

The categories which the fire service consider to be a vulnerable adult are:

- Smoker.
- Lives alone.
- Over 60 years old.
- In receipt of care (informal, formal or both).
- No working smoke alarms.
