## Drama and Movement Therapy Service

The Clinical Health Team for people with Learning Disabilities



The weekly group is a space to explore and develop confidence around sexuality, gender identity and relationships. The programme brings together psycho-educational tools and creative exploration using Drama and Movement Therapy. It invites discussion and reflection, experiential learning and role play.

What it's about: a weekly group which offers workshops on the theme of 'sex and relationships' within the framework of Drama and Movement therapy. It provides a safe place to explore creatively, to talk about your feelings and ask questions. It is a place where you will be able to connect with other people living with Learning Disabilities, where you can exchange life experiences and your everyday feelings, no matter what those feelings may be.

**EXPLORING SAFELY WITH SUPPORT**: the group will support you to grow in confidence and feel safe enough to explore and reflect your feelings and life stories. Sharing is at the heart of the group but you share however much you are comfortable with . The group provides an always friendly space where your presence is always very much appreciated and your contributions always welcome.

WHO IS IT FOR: This group is for people living with mild and moderate learning Disabilities of all genders and sexualities, people who are gender fluid, transgender or questioning, over the age of 18 years old.

HOW TO JOIN: New members are always welcome. You can self-refer but also be referred by professionals such as social workers, therapists, GP's, care managers - or your parents.
